Partnering with our friends at the Chamber Music Society of Williamsburg, we have put together six concerts, including two piano trios, three string quartets, and a special ensemble comprised of players from Philadelphia's Baroque chamber group, Tempesta di Mare.

This year, all concerts will be held on Monday nights at the **Chrysler Museum of Art's Kaufman Theater**. **All concerts will start at 7:30pm**. We will also offer pre-concert talks by WHRO's regional treasure, Dwight Davis at 7:00pm, and doors will open for light refreshments at 6:30pm. Season ticket prices are \$150, with special rates of \$125 for Chrysler Museum members, and \$75 for students, music professionals, and first-time subscribers.
