Welcome to the Feldman's 72nd Season of Music Worth Hearing! I am very pleased to report that in our annual survey results you rated the quality of the Feldman ensembles as an overall 4.94 out of 5.00 possible points! Bringing you chamber music of absolute uncompromising quality remains our top priority and I am confident you will find that to be the case again this year.

Again this year, all concerts will be held on Monday nights at the **Chrysler Museum of Art's Kaufman Theater**. **All concerts will start at 7:30pm**. We will also offer pre-concert talks by WHRO's regional treasure, Dwight Davis at 7:00pm, and doors will open for light refreshments at 6:30pm. (*Please note that unfortunately for contractual and museum security reasons we cannot open the doors before 6:30pm.*) Season ticket prices remain \$150, with special rates of \$125 for Chrysler Museum members, and \$75 for students, music professionals, and first-time subscribers. Single tickets are \$30, \$25, and \$15 respectively.
